Winter Safety Tips

Outdoor Ice Skating



- Skate only on City or community outdoor rinks.
- The Markham Civic Centre outdoor refrigerated ice rink is open daily, providing a safe and accessible leisure option for residents. Skating is free, and skate rentals are available.
- Please stay off of Markham's ponds, stormwater ponds and waterways as the ice is unsafe. These ponds are designed to have water flowing in and out of them all year long (from rainfall and snow melt), making the ice unpredictable and an unsafe place to play.

Tobogganing



- Find a safe place for tobogganing. Avoid any areas where signs have been posted stating that the location is dangerous & unsafe.
- Avoid icy hills and snow piles in the middle of a cul-de-sac.
- Always lie flat on your back.
- Do not toboggan at night.

Winter Parking Guidelines



Winter parking restrictions are in effect from November 15 to April 15 each year to accommodate traffic flow, emergency response vehicles, road maintenance and snowplows.

- All on street parking is prohibited during snow clearing operations and/or winter maintenance.
- Parking exemptions and permits are not valid during winter operations. Vehicles parked on a City street during snow clearing and/or winter operations will be ticketed and/or towed.
